Player Parent Agreement

Welcome to the 2026 soccer year of Dynamo Soccer Academy (DSA). Upon signing this Agreement, both the player and parent(s)/guardian(s) become members of Dynamo Soccer Academy (“DSA” or “Club”) for the full soccer year.

The player agrees to prioritize DSA as their primary soccer training program and to attend practices and games consistently. If the player participates in additional teams or activities, any conflicts with DSA schedule should be minimized.

Participation in State Cup competitions or official matches with another club is not permitted without prior approval from DSA. Any outside tournaments or additional team participation must be coordinated and approved by DSA coaching staff in advance.

Player Code of Conduct

At Dynamo Soccer Academy (DSA), we expect all players to:

- Treat teammates, coaches, opponents, and referees with respect at all times
- Show good sportsmanship both on and off the field
- Listen to coaches and follow instructions during training and games
- Attend practices and games on time and be prepared to participate
- Wear appropriate training and game attire
- Take care of all facilities and equipment
- Communicate respectfully if they have questions or concerns
- Always give their best effort and maintain a positive attitude

Parent Code of Conduct

At DSA, we believe a positive environment is essential for player development. Parents/guardians agree to:

- Support their child and the team in a positive and respectful manner
- Respect coaches, players, referees, and other families
- Encourage effort, development, and teamwork over winning
- Avoid coaching or giving instructions from the sidelines
- Allow coaches to guide and manage the team
- Address any concerns respectfully and directly with DSA staff
- Follow the 24-hour rule before discussing game-related concerns
- Maintain respectful behavior at all times during practices and games
- Avoid negative comments in person or on social media

At Dynamo Soccer Academy (DSA), these standards are in place to ensure a safe, positive, and professional environment for all players. Parents/guardians are expected to support and follow these guidelines in the best interest of their child and the team.

DSA coaching staff may address any concerns or behavioral issues as they arise. Depending on the situation, action may be taken with or without prior warning.

Failure to follow these guidelines may result in consequences, including removal from training sessions or games, and, if necessary, further disciplinary action.

DSA Tuition & Program Fees

By enrolling in Dynamo Soccer Academy (DSA), the parent/guardian agrees to commit to the full program period as outlined at the time of registration.

The parent/guardian is responsible for:

- Payment of all program fees, including training fees, uniforms, and any additional program-related costs
- Making an initial, non-refundable deposit (if applicable)
- Completing all scheduled payments according to the agreed payment plan

ROSTER COMMITMENT & NO REFUND POLICY

Due to the structure of youth soccer programs, roster spots at Dynamo Soccer Academy (DSA) are limited. During registration periods, the number of players interested in joining typically exceeds the number of available spots.

When a player is accepted and enrolled, DSA reserves a dedicated roster position specifically for that player. This spot is held exclusively and will not be offered to another player once registration is confirmed. As a result, if a player later withdraws, it becomes difficult for the academy to replace that position with another player of similar level and commitment, which may impact the team and overall program. For this reason, enrollment in DSA represents a full commitment for the program period.

By registering and making the first payment, the parent/guardian:

- Confirms the player's spot within the program
- Agrees to complete all financial obligations in full
- Understands that the reserved roster position cannot be transferred or replaced

If a player withdraws from the program:

- All remaining fees become immediately due
- The full balance must be paid within 10 days of notice
- The player will be officially released from the program once obligations are fulfilled

All payments made to DSA are non-refundable under any circumstances.

By enrolling, the parent/guardian acknowledges and accepts this policy as a necessary part of maintaining a stable and professional academy environment.

Financial Acknowledgment & Club Authority

The parent/guardian understands that the program fees support the overall structure and operation of Dynamo Soccer Academy (DSA), including coaching, field rentals, league participation, and player development.

By enrolling, the parent/guardian confirms that they have reviewed all terms and had sufficient time to consider this commitment prior to registration.

Club Structure & Decision-Making

Dynamo Soccer Academy (DSA) operates as a professional training environment. All decisions are made by DSA coaching staff and management, including but not limited to:

- Team formation and roster decisions
- Coaching assignments and training structure
- League and tournament participation
- Player positions and roles
- Playing time and game participation

All decisions are made in the best interest of player development and the team. These decisions are final. Disagreement with coaching or program decisions does not affect financial obligations and is not a basis for refunds or credits.

The parent/guardian acknowledges that the financial commitment to Dynamo Soccer Academy (DSA) is necessary to support the structure and operation of a professional youth soccer program, including coaching, facilities, leagues, and overall player development.

By enrolling, the parent/guardian confirms that they have reviewed and accepted all financial terms and have had sufficient time to consider this commitment. The parent/guardian also understands that all families within the program are held to the same financial obligations to ensure fairness and stability across all teams.

By accepting a position within DSA, the parent/guardian acknowledges that the academy operates as a structured and professionally managed program. All operational and technical decisions are made by DSA coaching staff and management.

These decisions include, but are not limited to:

- Team formation and roster structure
- Coaching assignments and potential coaching changes
- League and tournament participation
- Player positions and roles
- Playing time and game participation

The parent/guardian understands that these decisions are made in the best interest of player development and team performance, and are final.

Disagreement with any of these decisions does not affect the parent's financial obligations and does not constitute grounds for refunds, credits, or any claim against DSA.

This level of commitment is necessary to maintain a stable and professional environment for all players. Allowing exceptions would negatively impact the team and other families within the program.

For this reason, no exceptions will be made to the academy's financial policies.

All training sessions, games, and program activities will take place as scheduled whenever reasonably possible, depending on weather conditions, field availability, or other external factors.

Any changes, cancellations, or rescheduling of activities do not affect financial obligations.

Playing Time

All playing time decisions at Dynamo Soccer Academy (DSA) are made by the coaching staff and are based on the academy's development philosophy, team needs, and individual player progress.

For younger age groups, DSA focuses on development, and players will typically receive playing opportunities during games. However, playing time may vary based on effort, attendance, attitude, and performance.

For older and more competitive teams, playing time is not guaranteed and is determined by the coach based on the needs of the game and team objectives.

DSA Media & Branding

All logos, branding, and materials of Dynamo Soccer Academy (DSA) are the exclusive property of the academy and may not be used without prior written permission.

DSA reserves the right to use photos and videos of players for promotional and marketing purposes, including social media, website, and other materials.

Parents/guardians agree that images or videos taken during training sessions, games, or events may be used by DSA unless otherwise requested in writing.

Dynamo Soccer Academy (DSA) Player Development Philosophy

Dynamo Soccer Academy (DSA) follows a structured pathway of player development based on age, level, and individual progress.

Our goal is to create an environment that balances development, confidence, and competitive growth.

Development Phase (Younger Players)

For younger age groups, the primary focus is on:

- Skill development
- Game understanding
- Confidence building
- Enjoyment of the game

Players in this stage will receive regular playing opportunities whenever possible, with an emphasis on learning rather than results.

Intermediate Phase

As players grow and progress, training becomes more structured and competitive.

- Playing time is influenced by effort, attendance, and development
- Coaches guide players on areas of improvement
- Players are encouraged to take responsibility for their growth

Competitive Phase (Older Players)

At higher levels, the program becomes more competitive.

- Playing time is not guaranteed
- Decisions are based on performance, effort, and team needs
- Coaches may adjust lineups to achieve the best team results

Players are expected to demonstrate commitment, discipline, and a strong work ethic.

Communication & Growth

DSA coaches are committed to supporting player development by:

- Providing feedback and guidance
- Helping players understand how to improve
- Encouraging direct communication between players and coaches
